GENERAL NOTES

MAY RALLY

MEMBERSHIP FEE'S

PCAV changed the date for the strength return from 15th June to 15th of May, this then allows them to process memberships and insurance by the 1st July. This in turn means our club fees due date has changed. All fees are now due at the May rally. Keeping in mind if fees are not paid by the due date riders will not be eligible to ride at the July rally.

2011 - 2012 Fee Description

\$250 Base membership fee

\$ 50 Working Bee Levy

\$ 50 SMZ Levy

Levy Description - Working Bee Levy: You need to attend 8 hours out of the pony club year to assist with our pony club grounds and equipment maintenance. We will be allocating 4 working bee days a year and as a member you will be required to attend 2 of those and volunteering your time. The working bee levy is \$50, if you attend 2 working bee's your levy can roll over to cover the next year. If you do not attend the required days/hours your fee will be used to pay contractors to help with the jobs.

SMZ (Southern Metropolitan Zone) Levy: It is compulsory for our club to send volunteers to allocated SMZ events. You must attend/volunteer at one of these events during the year, this rule applies to all members of the SMZ. If a member cannot participate for their one SMZ duty for the year the money from their levy can be used to cover the costs of petrol to the members that have to volunteer more than once for our compulsory SMZ duties.

After we have received the completed membership forms we will then be creating a roster for our members to help in canteen and with pony club duties.

The jumps trailer will also be going on to our roster list and we will need a member to tow it out this upcoming rally.

- * **SET UP & PACK UP:** We require all members to assist with the chores of setting up and packing up. If we can all leave our horses either in a day yard or tied to a float and make sure every area is ready for our first morning lesson and then again in the afternoon and help pack up we can all leave around the same and reasonable time. If you see an area that is not ready even though yourself or child are not using that area please pitch in and help we are all here to learn and these jobs need to be done.

IMPORTANT

Committee appointed Brenna Garlick as the DC of SPPC and Jenine Gorton to take on the Presidents position.

Freshmans's Jumping is now known as Jump's Training Day, the PCAV enforced the name change and will be called this from April onwards.
