SPPC NEWS

Early Start on a cold miserable day, I headed out to my first horse trials, not knowing what to expect... being just weeks before, doing my coccyx, my trust in Baci and myself had gone out the window, and was very hard to having to get back on him. Getting there, dazzled as ever not trying to mix up dressage tests that had be learnt, in the pouring non-stop rain, myself and a few friends walked the muddy, steep, wet, long XC course where at this time, was wondering is it safe to go on? looking at all the jumps, from grade 5 to 1, was just amazing and that motivated me to be able to get there one day.....by the time dressage came, the grounds had been litted up, with mud and puddles showing the track where other horses had been. by the time show jumping came, the judges did not mind so much on presentation of our horses and uniform due to the fact that it was just so muddy and wet, and it was near impossible not to be soaked. after being pleased with the way baci had performed in both sj and dressage, with only having one refusal due to him slipping from my hard line, my main focus was to get around cross country as safely as possible, after one of my friends horses slipped on him, causing him to be dissqualified, this freaked me out a bit. So our turn came, being as careful as ever, we cantered to our first jump, where the scary men in the fluoro jackets were not a fuss for baci, we cruised our way around, walking down this steep slippery hill, having a nice gallop along the solid straight and being able to finish the course with ease. we did make it as a clear round apart forgetting to take a left to the jump, which i had to cross tracks to jump, and from going over time, ending up that we were disqualified, which when thinking, i had a great time, and i was very pleased with how my pony went, even though i did not win, i was so proud with the choices that were made (apart from spending many hours with 20 kettels giving him a hot bath the day before) i was so happy i had that opputunity to go out to a horse trials and would really love to do more in the future :D

Jumping heights & spreads as per PCAV Horse Trials rules Feb 2010 (Table C.11.4)

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions.

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
2. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
3. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An Administration fee of \$5 will be deducted.
4. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
5. PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the event office before riding.
6. Medical armbands must be worn by all competitors, pony club riders must be in full uniform.
7. Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in the PCAV Gear Rules. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination. Complying Standards are AS/NZS 3838, EN 1384, ASTM F 1163 or PAS 015.
8. Gear check 20 minutes before riding in each phase of the competition is required.
9. Competitor numbers – the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers. Body numbers will be available at the event.
10. Queries, protests, horse abuse rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
11. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
12. Horses must be at least 4 years of age, no rigs, stallions or colts.
13. No lungeing is permitted at venue.
14. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
